

JTF Participant Roles

The IMC-GCF Joint Task Force asks that participating companies plan to play one of two roles in the online/offline work of the JTF. Those two roles are...

Project Leads: a company representative can choose to participate as a lead in at least one of several working groups. Project Leads will be asked to research market demand for IoT standards/certifications, or to research existing standards applied to various layers of the IoT technology stack. They will assimilate this research into presentations to be given at monthly online calls for review and approval by the JTF as a whole. Ad hoc calls may be required, but total man-hours are not expected to exceed five hours monthly – we assume that people interested in this role are already pursuing the subjects covered in their work roles. Public citation for work product will be given to Project Leads, and JTF approval processes will be weighted to give priority to their recommendations.

Project Advisors: as the name suggests, play an advisory role, reviewing materials presented by Project Leads and offering opinions (and votes) on recommendations. Project Advisors will not be asked to serve on sub-groups covering specific issues, but they will be asked to review all materials presented to the JTF and to be prepared to offer salient comment. Ad hoc calls and assignments are generally not required, but attendance at monthly online calls is mandatory. It is expected that total man-hours required will not exceed two hours monthly for Project Advisors.
